The State Conference is open to 2018 member schools only and is subsidised by LSA in support of teachers and schools having limited professional development budgets.

Two day Registration Fees include lunch and refreshments, Conference Dinner and one set of Conference Papers. Schools may choose to send a different teacher for each day. One-day attendance does not include the Dinner. Additional teachers may attend the Conference Dinner at a cost of \$90.

Registration closes on Friday 2 March 2018. However no registrations will be accepted once the available places are filled, which may occur before the closing date. Unsuccessful applicants will be placed on a waiting list. **Conference cancellations will not be refunded after the registration closing date.**

Please be aware that all participants **MUST** have received a confirmation email from LSA in order to be admitted to the Conference. Unless you have a confirmation email we will be unable to admit you to the Conference.

Unfortunately we have, in the past, been faced with a small number of incidents where colleagues have presented for admission to the Conference on the day although we have not received payment or application. This has caused considerable inconvenience and embarrassment to all concerned.

Due to limited places available there has always been a waiting list of people wishing to attend. Those on this list are entitled to be considered first in the event of any vacancies arising. The LSA confirms numbers prior to the event to enable catering and other arrangements to be locked in and we are unable to provide for anyone not registered and in receipt of a confirmation from the LSA.

Please note that registration can not be accepted from NSW DEC LMBR schools without a pre-payment purchase order number. Please ensure that you provide the PO number on your registration form – without this number, your registration WILL NOT BE RECORDED.
